		Is your home address properly displayed on the front of your home with 4* numbers so emergency vehicles can quickly identify them?
		Do you have working smoke detectors located on each floor of your home?
		Have you tested your smoke detectors lately?
		Have you installed Carbon Monoxide detectors?
		Have you had your furnace cleaned and inspected by a qualified contractor in the past year?
		Have you had your water heater cleaned and inspected by a qualified contractor in the past year?
		Have you had your fireplace chimney cleaned and inspected in the past year?
		Do you have flammable liquids (paint, varnishes etc.) improperly stored near combustible appliances like your furnace or water heater?
		Do you have several electrical appliances plugged into a single outlet?
		Do you have electric cords placed under rugs?
		Do you have electric cords placed in a way that may cause a trip hazard?
		Have you installed a multi-purpose fire extinguisher in case of a small fire? (Locations to consider: kitchen, laundry room, garage.)
		Do you and your family have or practice a home fire escape plan, complete with a meeting place?
		Are all the members of your family aware that the correct emergency number to dial in case of an emergency is 911 ?
		Do you have a list of current medications or health concerns for each one of your family members?
		Are any of your family members certified by the American Heart Association in CPR?
