## **Lisle-Woodridge Fire District**

### **Vehicle Fire**

At 1244 hours on 21 June 2017, the Lisle – Woodridge Fire District was notified by way of a 911 call from a visitor at the Morton Arboretum (4100 Rt. 53, Lisle, IL) reporting a vehicle fire in a remote parking lot.

A Still Alarm was immediately dispatched, sending one (1) engine, one (1) ladder truck and one (1) Battalion Chief, for a minimum of seven (7) Lisle – Woodridge Fire District personnel.

The first unit arrived on scene at 1257 hours and reported a fully involved vehicle fire.

Fire units deployed a hose line to attack the fire, which was extinguished in less than 10 minutes.

Immediately after the fire was extinguished, a body was found inside the vehicle.

The Lisle-Woodridge Fire District fire investigation team is assisting the DuPage County Fire Investigation Task Force. No further information is available at this time. Additional information will be disseminated as it becomes available.
