**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Communications personnel of DU-COMM daily serve the public in countless ways without due recognition by the beneficiaries of their services.



**“NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK”**


within the Lisle-Woodridge Fire District and commends the devotion, contributions, and services of the DU-COMM Telecommunicators.


