The Lisle-Woodridge Fire District responded to 723 incidents this month. We are 195 incidents ahead of last year. 463 (64%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Services and the remaining 260 (36%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 80 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 79 times.

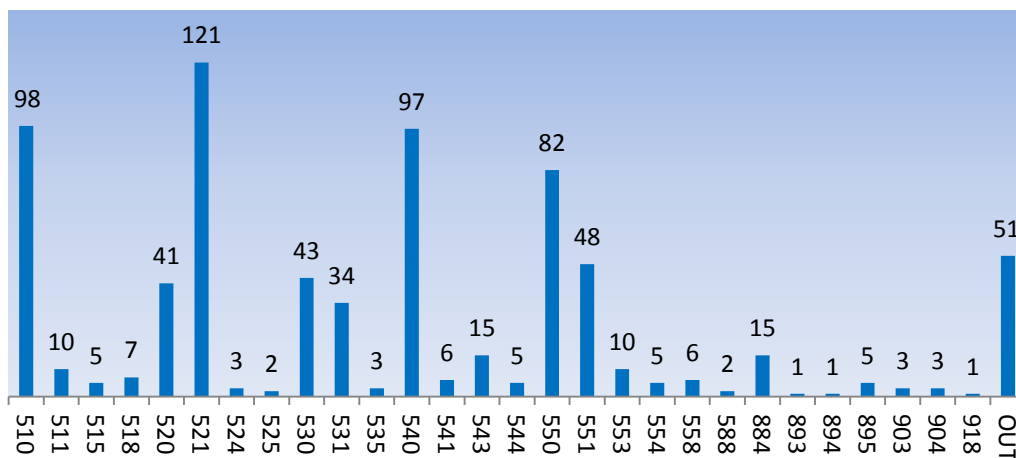
