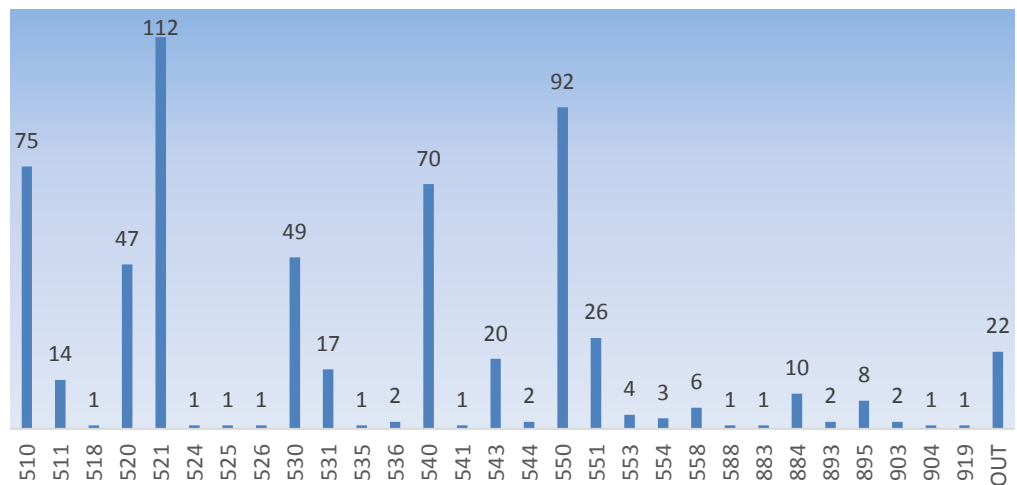

Total incidents year to date is 3,701. 413 (70%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Services and the remaining 180 (30%) were Fire/Rescue related.
