


Monthly Summary

The Lisle-Woodridge Fire District responded to 596 incidents this month. Total incidents year to date is 1,893; this is 235 incidents ahead of last year. 412 (69%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Services and the remaining 184 (31%) were Fire/Rescue related.

We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 49 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 44 times.
