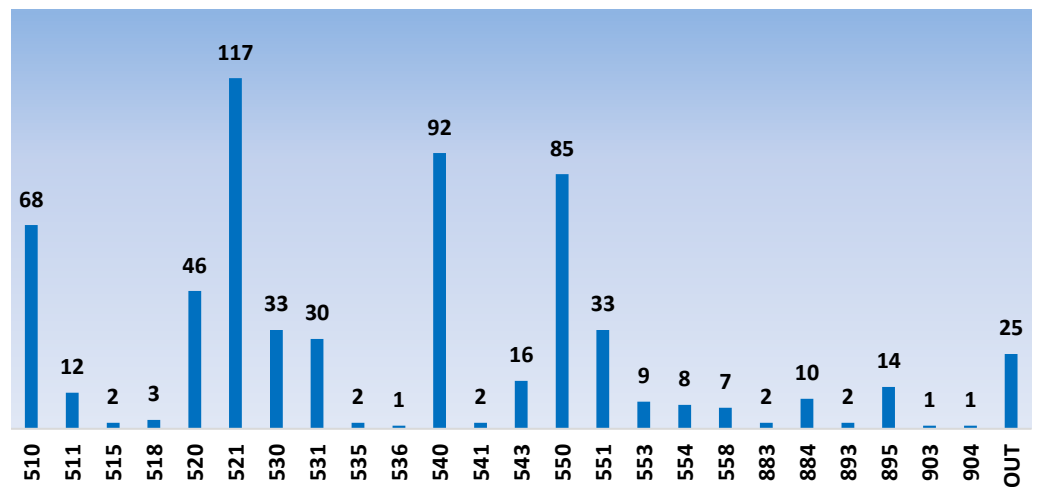

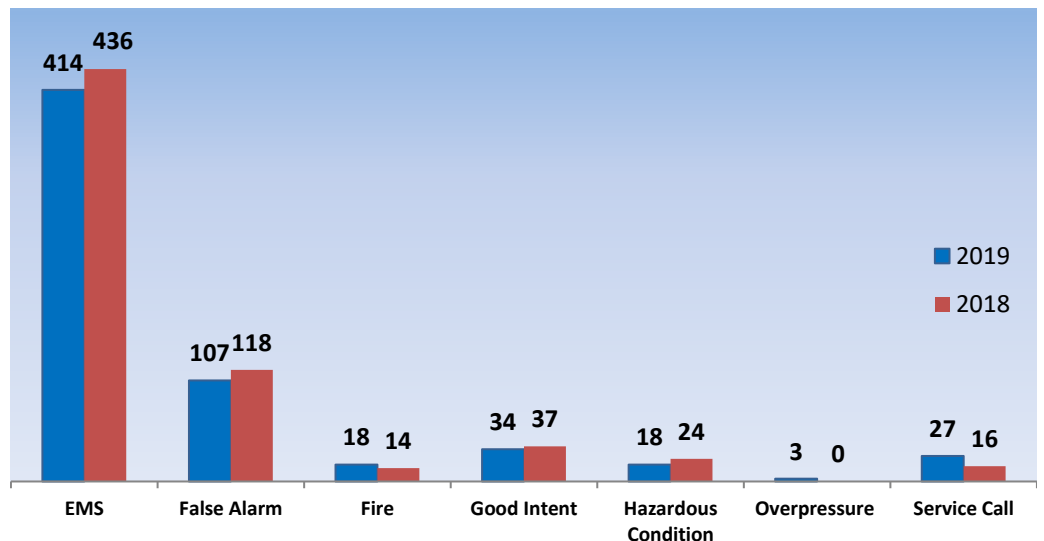
Monthly Summary

The Lisle-Woodridge Fire District responded to 621 incidents this month. Total incidents year-to-date is 3,110. 414 (67%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Medical Services and the remaining 207 (33%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 27 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 59 times.

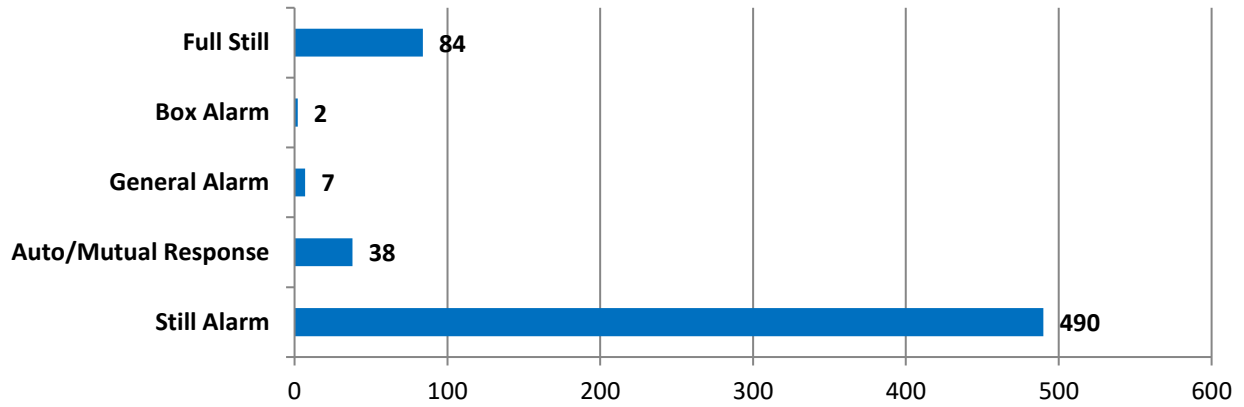
INCIDENT BY DISTRICT



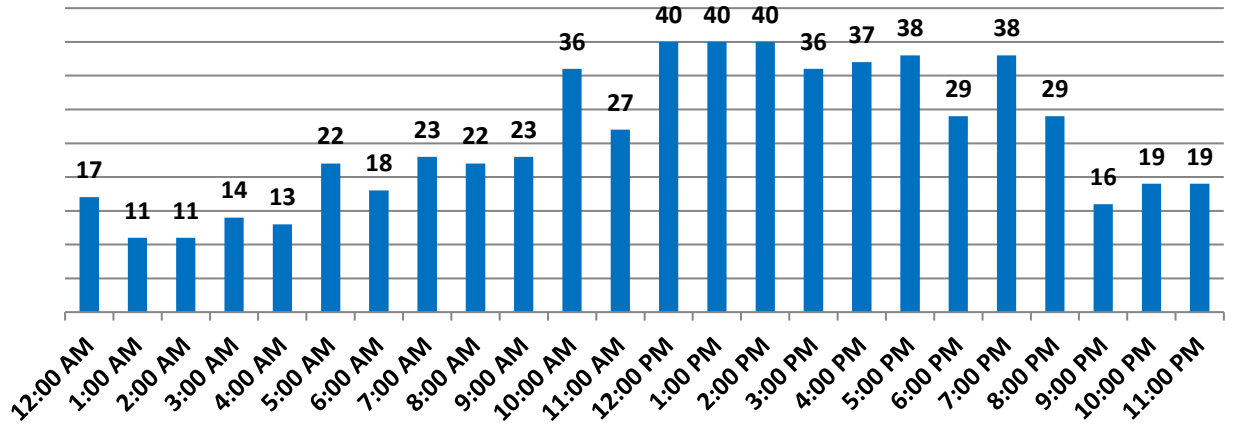
INCIDENT TYPE



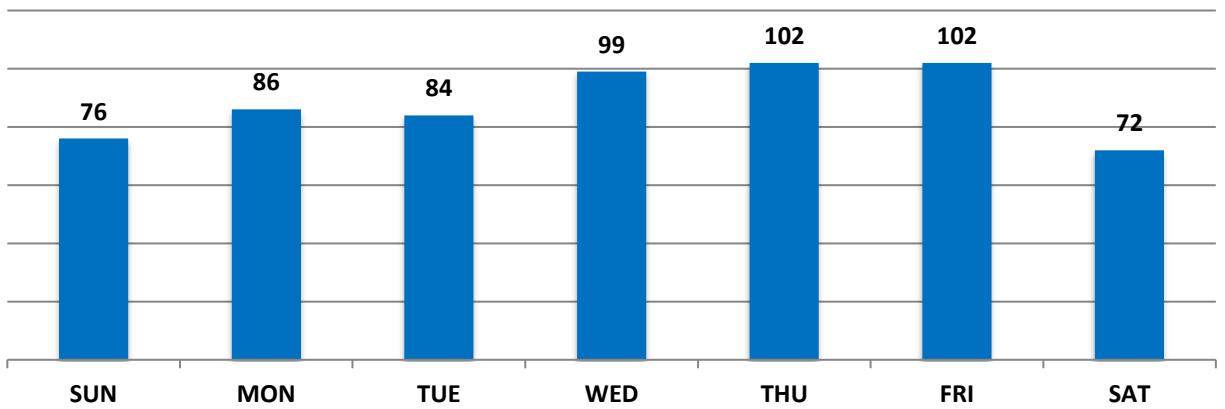
TYPE OF ALARM



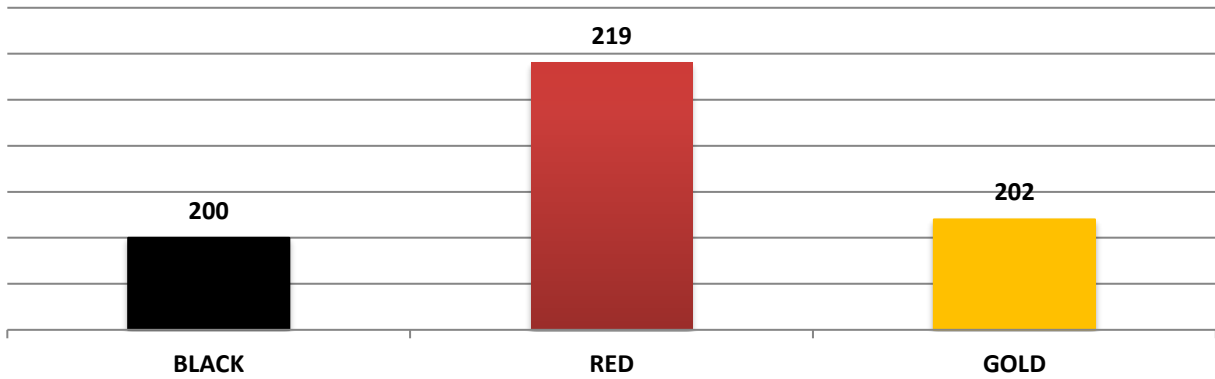
NUMBER OF CALLS PER HOUR



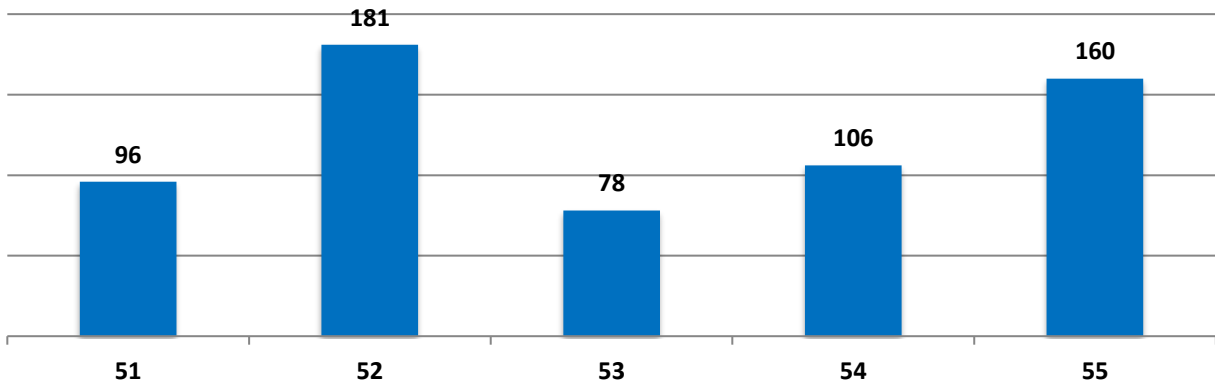
INCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK
