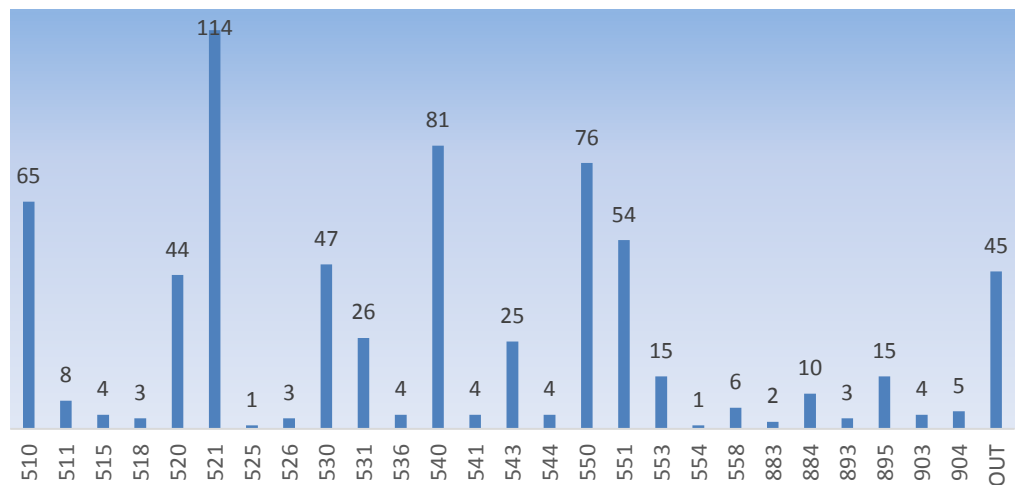

Total incidents year-to-date is 6,347. 427 (64%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Medical Services and the remaining 242 (36%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 84 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 77 times.
