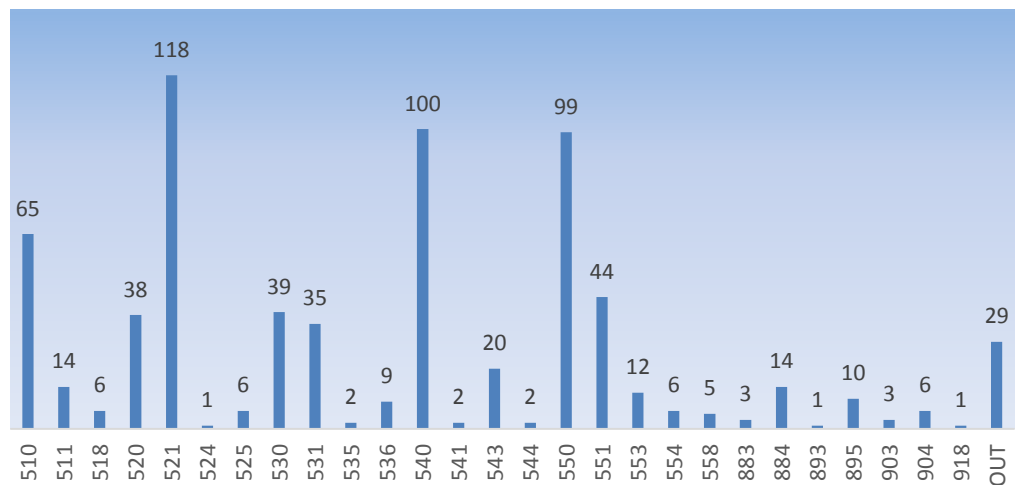

Total incidents year-to-date is 5,678. 471 (68%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Medical Services and the remaining 219 (32%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 69 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 60 times.
