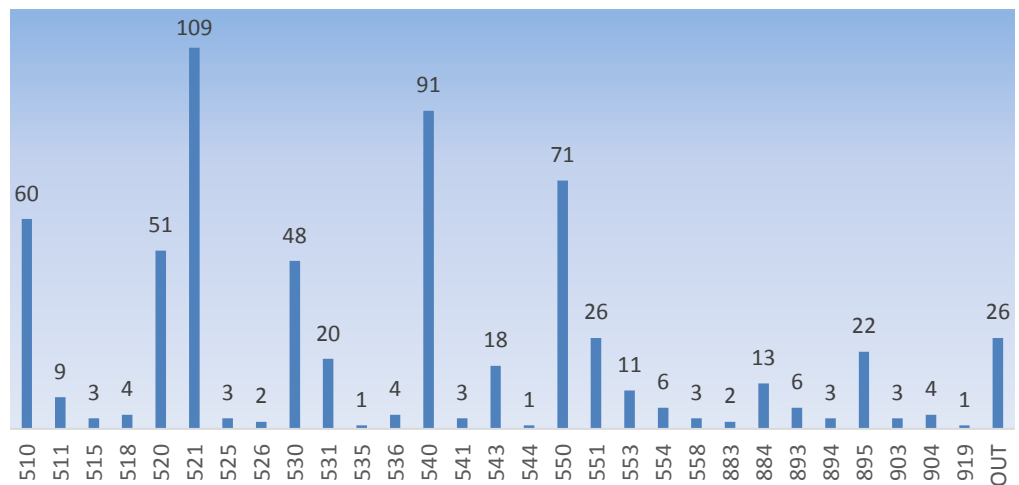

Total incidents year-to-date is 4,325. 428 (69%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Medical Services and the remaining 196 (31%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 55 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 52 times.
