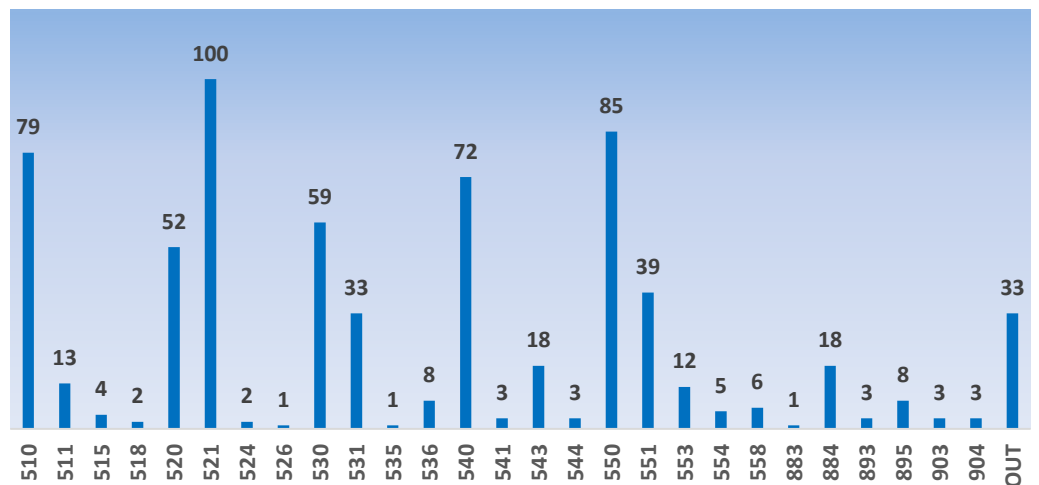

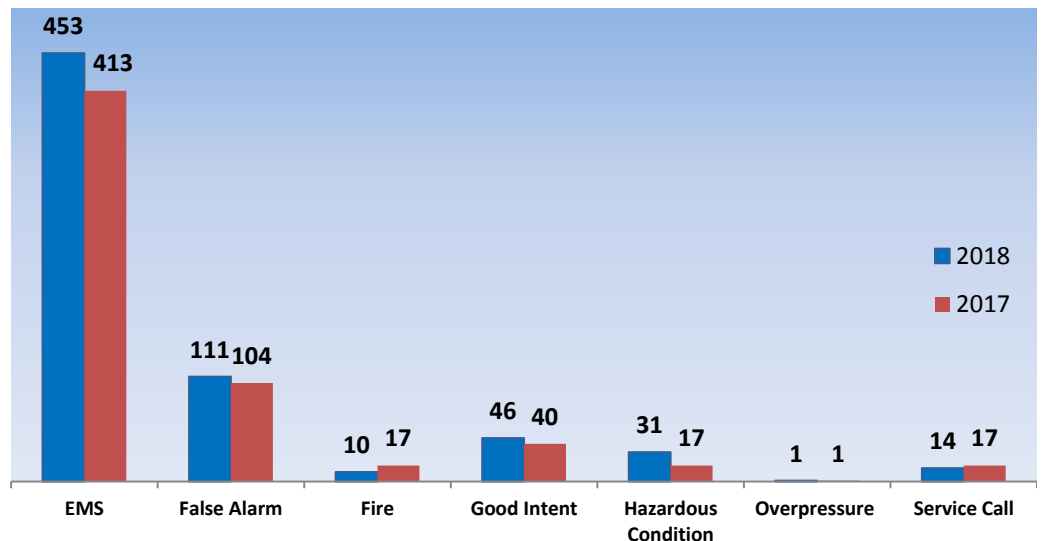
Monthly Summary

Total incidents year-to-date is 7,013. 453 (68%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Medical Services and the remaining 213 (32%) were Fire/Rescue related. We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 69 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 54 times.

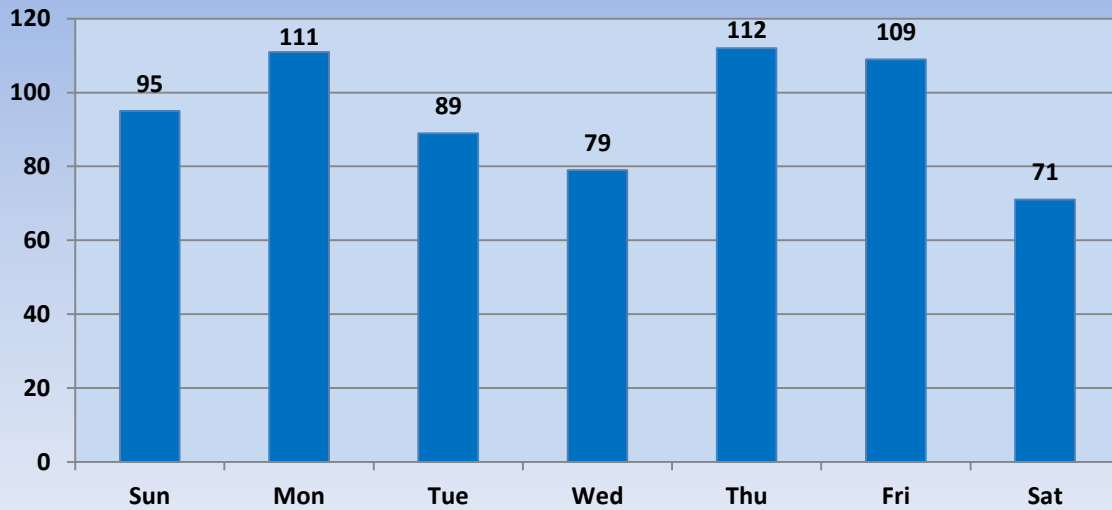
INCIDENT BY DISTRICT



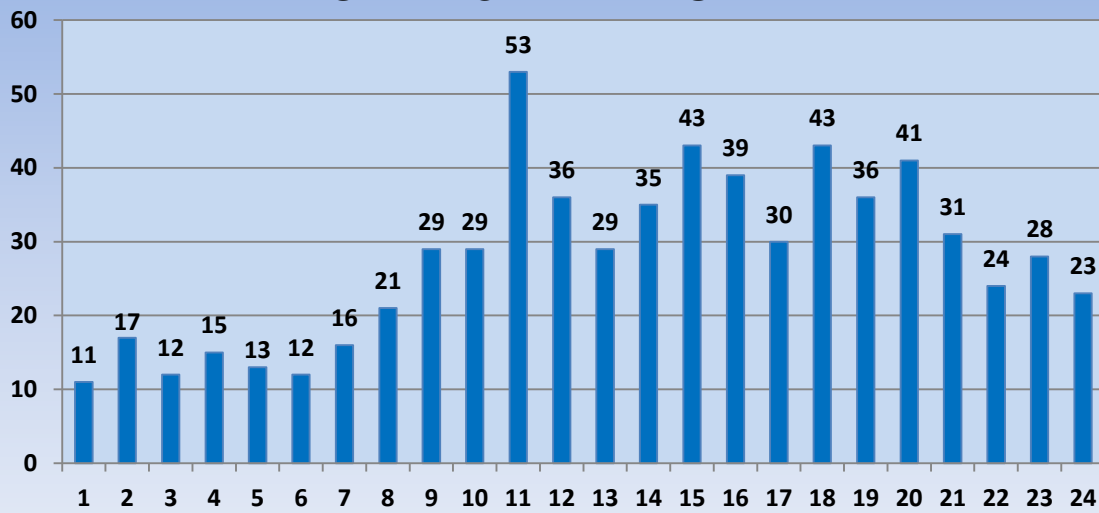
INCIDENT TYPE



INCIDENTS BY DAY OF WEEK



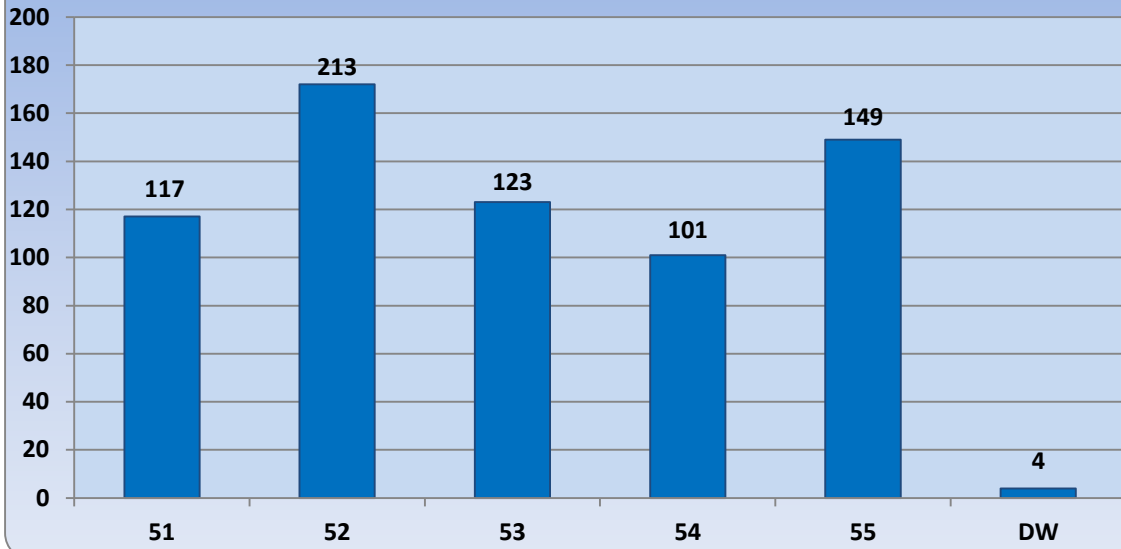
INCIDENTS BY TIME OF DAY



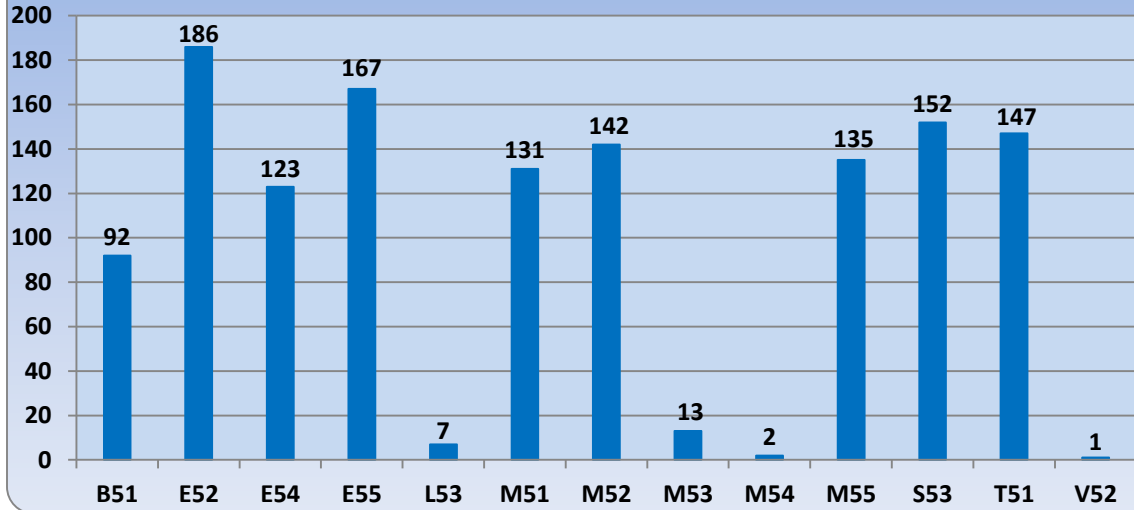
INCIDENTS BY SHIFT
